When Geoffrey was brought to Achego Childcare Centre in Kenya because **he could no longer be cared for at home, he was a preschooler.**

He lived at the Achego Centre throughout his entire primary and secondary school years. How joyful he was last March when he graduated from Kapsabet Bible College with a diploma in Theology. Geoffrey can now serve his Saviour in the ministry of proclamation of the Word of God.

The manager of the Achego Centre reports that during devotion times the children do not forget to mention their sponsors in Canada: “God bless our sponsors in Canada that have not seen us except in pictures, but they have given themselves to love and support us.” The children also chant this slogan, “United in Christ with CRWRF!”

When orphaned children have a relative who is able to help provide for them in a family home, the Family First Focus (FFF) supports the family by helping with food, education and financial contributions. In this way, orphaned children can be nurtured in the caring environment of an immediate family member whenever possible.

FAMILY ACTIVITY: Imagine how much you would miss your family if you couldn't stay at home, like Geoffrey. Take time to give thanks for each person in your family, and ask for God's special grace on those who no longer have a mother and father to raise them.
