In December of 2022 a storm hit Kinshasa, the capital of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), and caused terrible flooding that killed more than 100 people and destroyed many homes and businesses, as well as the main highway that provides the transportation of goods to Kinshasa. In the months following this flooding we have worked with Mission French Africa Ministries (MFAM), whose training center was also flooded, by providing food for those most affected by the flooding in the area.

July BB MALI

In Bamako, Mali, we've been supporting a development project focused on women's health, abuse prevention, and Christian family life. The overall goal is to improve the health and wellbeing of community members, especially survivors of abuse and those with high vulnerability to abuse. Currently in phase five of this program, our partner AMAFEP has been leading training in local churches to improve knowledge in health, STIs, reproductive health issues, and how to prevent and report abuse. It also aims to equip churches so that they can protect children, prevent and respond to abuse, and care for survivors of abuse.

- Pray for the AMAFEP staff and 15 training facilitators.

Benefat

In Linguère, Senegal, we've been supporting a development project that focuses on increasing food security for People Living with HIV/AIDS, their families, and their neighbours. This is primarily done through community vegetable gardens and nutritional training. So far, eleven gardens have been established. Farmers receive training and mentoring from the staff at SLDS (Lutheran Senegalese Development Service). The gardens allow families to eat more nutritious meals, and there is often excess produce that can be sold at the market. In some communities, farmers have created solidarity funds to pool their money and help community members with larger expenses.

September Timor

In Timor, New Hope Indonesia (Timor) aims to bring hope to those who are in despair by providing Christian relief aid, as well as opportunities for Christian education. In this predominantly Muslim country, even most Christians have very little understanding of God's word. The seven New Hope schools serve 1,000+ students (kindergarten to high school, and vocational school). A number of boys and girls also live in the New Hope Homes. The relief efforts have increased recently, in the wake of extreme flooding and a massive landslide which, among other things, has made it more difficult to access and afford food and gas.

- Pray for encouragement for the staff and teachers, in the face of strong government opposition.
- Pray that teachers may receive wisdom to teach the government curriculum with a Biblical perspective.

- Pray for counselors to focus on bringing hope to the children living in the New Hope Homes.
- Pray for those involved in relief efforts, especially when they face opposition.

LEBANON

In Lebanon, CRWRF has partnered with MERATH to provide support to refugees from Syria who have fled the war since its start in 2011. Syrian refugees in Lebanon are particularly vulnerable because there are no refugee camps where they can live for free, and there are severe restrictions on work, limiting livelihood opportunities and making it almost impossible for families to cover their basic needs. Working through World Renew, MERATH has been able to address some of these needs by providing milk, diapers, and feminine hygiene products.
